Introduction

Circular Ventures Ltd trading as EPiC Solutions ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. Data Collection

We may collect and process the following personal data:

- 1. Contact Information: Name, address, email address, and phone number.
- 2. **Property Information**: Details about the property, including address, type, and energy performance data.
- 3. Financial Information: Payment details for services rendered.
- 4. **Assessment Data**: Information collected during energy and retrofit assessments, including energy usage, retrofit recommendations, and improvement data.
- 5. **Communication Records**: Correspondence and communication history between you and us.

Legal Basis for Processing

We process personal data based on the following legal grounds:

1. **Consent**: When you have given explicit consent for us to process your personal data for specific purposes.

- 2. **Contractual Necessity**: To fulfill our contractual obligations to you, such as providing energy and retrofit assessments.
- 3. **Legal Obligation**: To comply with legal and regulatory requirements.

Use of Personal Data

We use personal data for the following purposes:

- 3. **Billing and Payments**: To process payments and manage billing.

- 5. **Improvement of Services**: To improve our services and develop new offerings.
- 6. **Marketing**: To send you information about our services, promotions, and updates, provided you have given consent.

Data Sharing and Disclosure

We do not share personal data with third parties except in the following circumstances:
